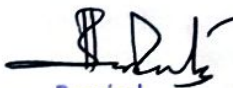
1. The meeting commenced with the introduction of all members present.

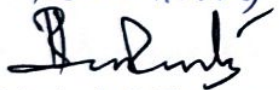

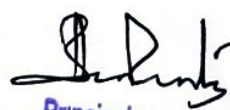

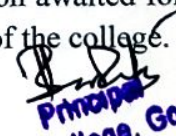
